**Testimony by Jennifer Reinert, Secretary
Department of Workforce Development**

Good Afternoon Chairman Hansen and Committee Members. Thank you for this opportunity to appear before you on Governor McCallum's appointment of me as Secretary of the Department of Workforce Development.

First, a bit on my background. I began my service with Wisconsin State Government in 1998 as the Administrator of the Division of Technology Management in the Department of Administration. In September 2000, I was appointed Secretary of the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) by former Governor Thompson. Governor McCallum re-appointed me as part of his administration shortly after he took office.

Prior to joining state service I spent 25 years in public education. I have taught at the elementary, high school, technical college and university levels and also had the pleasure of serving as a special education director and high school principal. It is from this experience that I've drawn to lead the Department of Workforce Development over the past year.

DWD is a state agency charged with building and strengthening Wisconsin's workforce in the 21st century and beyond. The Department's primary responsibilities include providing assistance to people looking for work through employment and training services and working with employers to find the necessary skilled workers they need to make their businesses a success.

The Department oversees and manages a host of programs with 2,360 employees and a \$2.45 billion budget biennially, 65 percent of which is funded with federal dollars.

Some of our programs and services include Worker's Compensation, Unemployment Insurance, Wisconsin Works (W-2) and related programs, Child Support, Child Care, Equal Rights enforcement (civil rights and labor standards laws), Vocational Rehabilitation and the Job Centers.

One of the first steps I took after becoming Secretary of DWD was to reinvigorate the Department's strategic planning efforts and create a process for the reengineering of vital services. Among the objectives I want to address through these avenues are:

- Looking for new and better ways to serve our customers
- Identifying what our highest priorities should be
- Eliminating low-value and obsolete activities
- Identifying new technologies to create efficiencies in program operations
- Developing critical indicators and performance measures for all department programs
- Recycling financial resources from low-value to high-value programs and services, in order to keep new budget requests to the Legislature at an absolute minimum

The strategic objectives we have identified for DWD involve three areas:

- Reducing the worker shortage and ensuring a skilled workforce by
 - encouraging the employment of people with disabilities,
 - promoting skills training through apprenticeship, local training programs and employer-sponsored training,
 - promoting safe work environments,
 - and, providing services to Wisconsin's low-income population to enable them to remain attached to and advance in Wisconsin's workforce.
- Exploring alternative revenue sources such as public and private grants and federal funding.
- And lastly, making DWD a performance-based agency focused on excellent customer service.

I'd like to touch briefly on this last point – excellent customer service. DWD touches the lives of tens of thousands of Wisconsin citizens on a daily basis. We oversee the processing of 20,000 child support checks on average each day, provide services to workers and employers through 78 Job Centers, offer "Rapid Response" services in plant closing or mass layoff situations and serve a caseload of approximately 19,000 people with disabilities to enter or reenter the workforce, among many other things. Not all of these situations are always pleasant, but I can assure you it is our priority to provide the best possible experience for individuals and families that require services from DWD.

The past year has already brought many successes.

- Creation of the "DVR Strategic Reform Task Force" which brought together advocates, academia, employers, disabled individuals and DWD staff to identify and present solutions to concerns with DVR services, bring order to DVR's finances and eliminate waiting lists for DVR services. A recent headline in the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel sums up what this Task Force has accomplished... "State Vocational Rehab Agency Earns Praise." Waiting lists have been virtually eliminated, the number of counselor positions has been increased, reliance on third-party contracts has been reduced and additional funding for case aid services statewide has been secured. The Task Force members deserve much praise, but we couldn't have accomplished this without support from the Legislature.

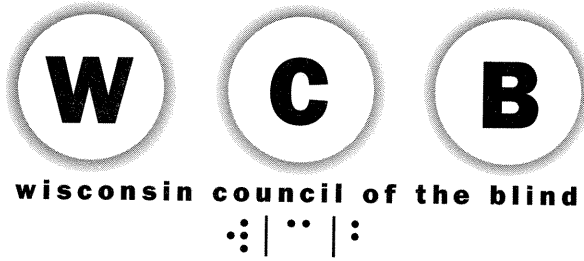
- Creation of a Milwaukee W-2 Advisory Panel to address service-delivery concerns with programs for low-income families in the Milwaukee area. W-2's success since 1997 is reflected in many measures. However, it remains an evolutionary program. Our intention in creating the Milwaukee panel is to continue the evolution by adapting the program to the needs of the changing caseload, particularly in the Milwaukee area. That is where about 8,500 of the 11,600 active W-2 cases (both cash and non-cash cases) reside. The panel has made substantial progress and we anticipate recommendations for significant program enhancements before the end of the year.

- Conducted public works construction site visits to improve compliance with state prevailing wage laws this past summer. *started 5/01*
- Initiated efforts to make employers more aware of child labor laws through educational visits to workplaces around the state. *started 7/01*
- Finalizing work on an internet-based system for unemployment claims which is scheduled to be implemented by November 1, 2001.
- Continuing on our initial success to reduce the time it takes to get a hearing on a worker's compensation claim, which has been reduced by approximately 10%. We will be aided in this effort by the addition of two administrative law judge positions that were approved in the budget.

Along with our continuing efforts in the strategic planning area and our focus on improved customer service, some of our upcoming initiatives include:

- Completion of the Unemployment Insurance tax and wage system redesign to replace an antiquated 20 year-old system.
- Implementing the federal Ticket to Work program for disabled social security recipients. Wisconsin is one of 13 early implementation states. The "tickets" will offer the opportunity for these individuals to enter the workforce without fear of losing their Medicaid coverage. *This fall*

I hope I've given you a glimpse of DWD's work over the last year and of the areas where our attention will be focused in the upcoming year. I want to thank you again for this opportunity to talk with you today and I would be happy to answer any questions you may have.

My apologies for not being with you for the April 24 committee hearing regarding my appointment to the State Fair Park Board.

This appointment is a responsibility I take seriously, along with your collective oversight role. Unfortunately, I had a long-standing commitment for a spring break vacation with my family. I would welcome any questions you may have of me in advance and I can be reached at (414) 287-4125.

In meeting with Sen. Hanson, prior to this hearing, I shared with him some of my background, and thoughts on the State Fair.

I have been president of the Metropolitan Milwaukee Association of Commerce (MMAC) for the past 8 years. I have worked previously with MMAC in both lobbying and economic development. Prior to MMAC, I worked in Washington D.C in a Congressional office, and under a Lyndon Baines Johnson Internship. I am a graduate of the University of Wisconsin Madison. I serve and have served on numerous outside boards, including Forward Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Sports Development Corporation and the Governor's Film Advisory Council.

The Wisconsin State Fair is one of the biggest attractions in greater Milwaukee, drawing some 2 million visitors to the grounds on a year-round basis. But first and foremost, it is a state asset, a significant celebration, and a learning venue for Wisconsin's agricultural community. I view a future where we can enhance this state asset with new investments and build on its role as an agricultural showcase.


No one appointed me to the Fair board for knowing which end of a cow to milk, but I do believe I have relevant and valuable experience to volunteer to this board. I was very involved in the Fair Park's strategic development commission, whose recommendations were encompassed in Act 197, which passed the Senate 33-0, and the Assembly 98-1.

My experience working on public/private building projects will be valuable as the Fair Park goes through its building phase. This phase will include a need for private sector contributions, as well as the hiring of a new Fair Park director.

While I am appointed by the Governor, I am mindful of the Senate's important role in the confirmation process. I am willing to give my time to improve and build upon one of the state's great assets, the Wisconsin State Fair Park.
