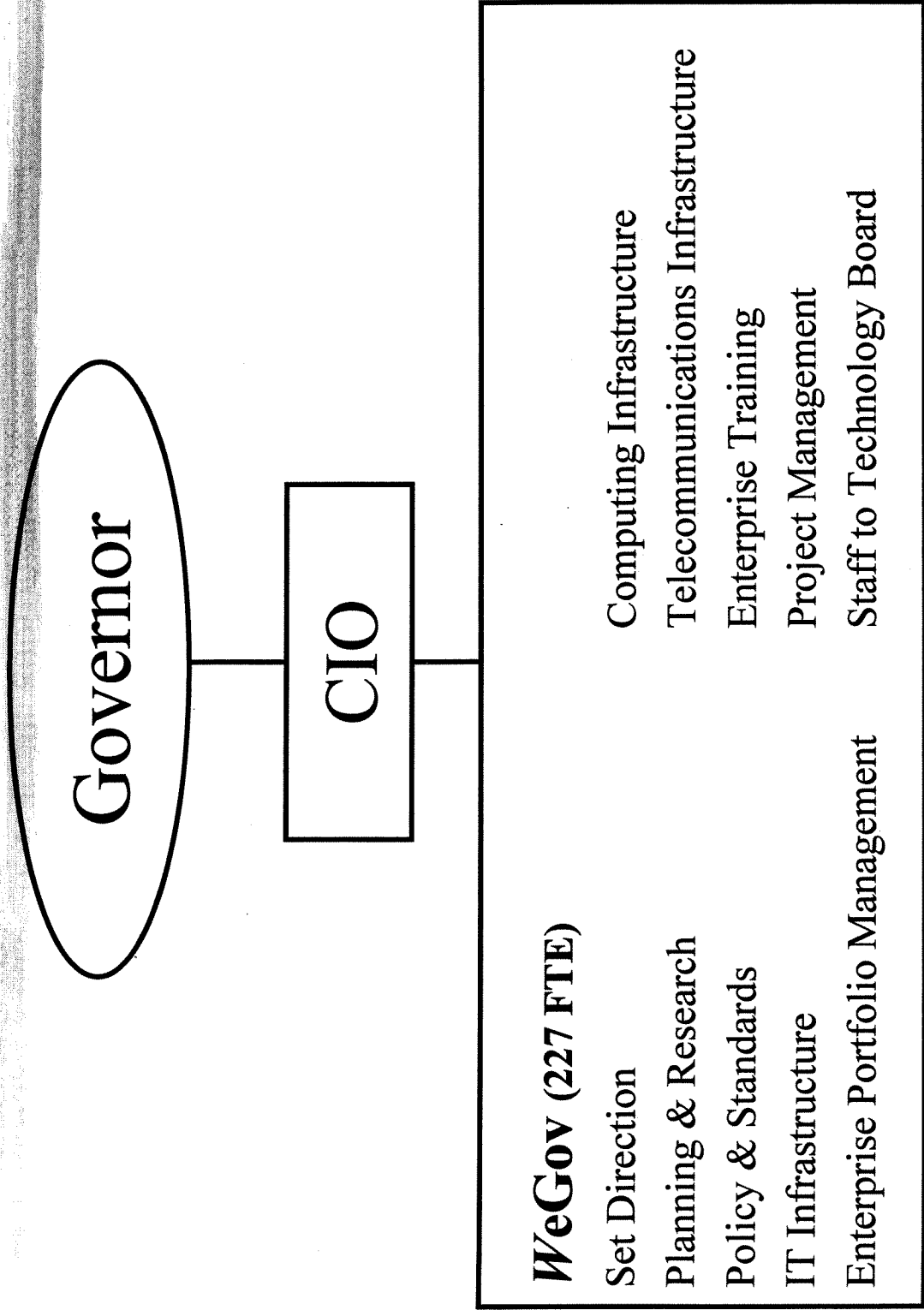
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# Why do we need change?

## *Faster/Better/More Cost Effective*

# Recommendations

- ◆ Create Cabinet level CIO with authority to control all IT activity in state executive branch agencies.
- ◆ CIO will work with agencies to consider what activities would be consolidated, outsourced or left in the agencies. IT Portfolio Management with group established by the CIO
- ◆ CIO serves as Secretary of the Dept. of Electronic Govt.
  - DTM and Info-Tech positions
  - Ability to transfer IT funding & positions from agencies, in conformance with state and federal law
  - Establish a basic operations appropriation;
  - Create a “E-gov Services” appropriation to pool agency funding to develop common/shared application and establish a framework for the “consortium” process

# Recommendations (cont.)

- ◆ Establish a Cabinet level Technology Board,
  - Chaired by the Governor,
  - Private sector members
  - Confirm strategic direction and advise the CIO
- ◆ Statutory Language changes to update the state's electronic signature law to conform with federal/uniform laws.
