RE: Paper Ballot – Senate Bill 163 – relating to the publication of notices relating to the creation of a tax incremental financing (TIF) district. Sponsored by Senator Risser; Cosponsored by Representative Berceau.

This bill allows the Department of Revenue to certify a tax incremental finance (TIF) district in Madison, Wisconsin despite technical deficiencies in the notices given in the creation of the district. The Committee previously approved a technical bill (Senate Bill 138) authorizing creation of two TIF districts in Madison that had not technically complied with the appropriate notice requirement. This bill authorizes creation of one, but not both, of those proposed TIF districts."
