**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 21**

April 24, 2003 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 5: after “(b)” insert “1.”

3 **2.** Page 2, line 6: delete “extending”.

4 **3.** Page 2, line 7: delete lines 7 to 10 and substitute “of inorganic materials, any  
5 portion of which is less than 6 inches in diameter, unless the vehicle is so loaded as  
6 to prevent the load from dropping or sifting from the vehicle and the highest point  
7 of the load is below the horizontal plane of the uppermost sides of the dump body or  
8 of any structural device installed to extend the sides of the dump body.”

9 **4.** Page 2, line 11: before that line insert:

10 “2. No person may load a vehicle or cause a vehicle to be loaded if the person  
11 has knowledge that the vehicle, as loaded, will be operated upon a highway in  
12 violation of subd. 1. Any person who loads or causes to be loaded, and then operates,

1 the same vehicle in violation of both this subdivision and subd. 1. is subject to only  
2 a single penalty under s. 348.11 (1) for such violations.”.

3 **5.** Page 2, line 12: after that line insert:

4 **“SECTION 3m. Effective date.**

5 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 7th month beginning after  
6 publication.”.
