**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 366**

November 20, 2003 - Offered by Representative BIES.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete that line and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 1b.** 36.11 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 6: delete lines 6 to 8 and substitute:

5 “**SECTION 1c.** 36.11 (3) (c) of the statutes is renumbered 36.11 (3) (c) (intro.) and
6 amended to read:

7 36.11 (3) (c) (intro.) The board may establish policies for the appropriate
8 transfer of credits with other educational institutions outside the system, except
9 that the board shall do all of the following:”.

10 **3.** Page 2, line 8: after that line insert:

11 “**SECTION 1d.** 36.11 (3) (c) 1., 2. and 3. of the statutes are created to read:

12 **36.11(c) 1.** Provide each technical college student who enrolls in the system
13 with a list of what technical college credits the system will accept for transfer, how

1 they will apply to the student's degree program, and what remaining courses the
2 student will need to complete his or her degree program.

3 2. For a student transferring from a liberal arts program at the Madison Area
4 Technical College, the Milwaukee Area Technical College, or Nicolet Technical
5 College, accept for transfer up to 72 credits to the system and allow the student to
6 satisfy his or her general education requirements at any institution.

7 3. Accept for transfer, occupational or technical courses taken by a technical
8 college student on a course-by-course basis.”.
