Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Legislative Audit Bureau (LAB) to administer a 12-year longitudinal study of the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program, which allows certain pupils who reside in the city of Milwaukee to attend a participating private school at no charge. The LAB must seek private sources of funding for the study. The bill directs the LAB to report the results of the study to the legislature periodically, the first report is due by October 1, 2005.


