Hi, Debora,

I have another drafting request. I'm assuming you would take care of this, but if not, please let me know to whom you have forwarded the request.

As a means of reducing medical errors, Sheldon wants to draft a bill requiring that all lab reports in hospitals and clinics are printed in no smaller than 14 point font. Dick Sweet advised that we may want to look at s. 255.04(1), Stats., as a statute that imposes requirements on hospitals and federally certified labs. Also, some of the statutes that require a particular print size are ss. 5.51(1) and 5.53(1) [ballots, 8 point]; 97.48(1)(b)1. [food products, 18 point]; 132.13(1)(a) [convict-made goods, 18 point]; 154.03(2) [living wills, 10 point]; and 241.27 [certain contracts, 10 point].
