February 7, 2002 – Introduced by Representatives ZIEGELBAUER, NASS, ALBERS, BIES, CARPENTER, COLON, GROTHMAN, HAHN, HINES, HUNDERTMARK, JESKEWITZ, KESTELL, KREIBICH, F. LASEE, LASSA, LEIBHAM, LIPPERT, LOEFFELHOLZ, MILLER, PETTIS, PLOUFF, REYNOLDS, SHILLING, STARZYK, STASKUNAS, STEINBRINK, SUDER, UNDERHEIM, WALKER, WASSERMAN, SERATTI and TOWNSEND, cosponsored by Senators HANSEN, DARLING, ROESSLER, ROSENZWEIG, SCHULTZ and ZIEN. Referred to Joint Committee on Employment Relations.

1     **AN ACT relating to:** salaries paid to the governor, state senators, and

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill provides that the governor is to receive an annual salary of \$122,406 during the 2003–04 legislature and that each state senator and representative to the assembly is to receive an annual salary of \$44,233 during the 2003–04 legislature. If this bill is not enacted, the governor will be paid an annual salary of \$131,768 during the 2003–04 legislature and each state senator and representative to the assembly will be paid an annual salary of \$45,569 during the 2003–04 legislature.

1 AN ACT *Gen. Cat*; relating to: salary reductions for state senators and representatives  
2 to the assembly during the 2005-~~03~~ legislature. *2006*

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill provides that the annual salary of each representative to the assembly and each state senator whose term of office begins on January 3, 2005, shall be paid an annual salary of \$44,233 during the 2005-~~03~~ legislature. Currently, during the *2004* 2003-~~03~~ legislature, each representative to the assembly and each state senator whose term of office begins on January 6, 2003, is paid an annual salary of \$45,569.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.
