#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The Equal Rights Division of the Department of Workforce Development enforces the portions of this bill relating to adding military stauts discrimination to the housing and public accommodations laws. Passage of this bill may cause a small increase in case load for the division, but not significant enough to require increased staff, since an Equal Rights Officer is expected to complete 132 cases per year. Informational brochures on the law that are published by the Equal Rights Division will need to be reprinted at an estimated cost of \$1,000 (GPR funded). This cost will be absorbed within the Equal Rights Division's budget.

This bill is also unlikely to have any significant impact on local government costs since only the small number of local governments that have a related case would have any costs.

#### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

There are no long-range fiscal implications for the department.
