1 AN ACT ...; relating to: exempting a county assessor and an assessor's staff from
2 liability for trespassing.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county surveyor and the surveyor's assistant who are required to subdivide a section or smaller subdivision of land may not be held liable as a trespasser and are only liable for any actual damage done to land or property. This bill provides a similar exemption from liability for trespassing for an assessor and the assessor's staff who are engaged in official business.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Mary:

Thanks for sharing the proposed bill. The wording in Section 2 is good, but the placement in the statutes (70.99) exempts only "county assessors." While the statutes authorize county assessors, we do not have any county assessors in the state. In Wisconsin all assessment is done at the local level by either elected or appointed contract assessors.

The Bureau analysis states "county surveyor." Statute 59.73(2) does not mention "county" at all. It states "...While so engaged a surveyor and the surveyor's assistants...". We need to have the word "county" removed from the assessor bill proposal and the new clause placed in Statute 70.32 to cover all assessors as the surveyors have in 59.73.

Let me know if there is anything further I can do on this.
