1. Problem/Issue: EXTEND 10pm-7am SHINING PROHIBITION TO JANUARY 31st

The deer 2000 rules that became effect February 1st, 2002 have extended the archery deer season to January 3rd in most areas of the state and to January 31st in the Metro units. The current Sept.15 - Dec. 31 restricted period was established to cover the entire archery and gun deer hunting seasons. It no longer will do so and should be corrected to cover the new January archery seasons.

2. Description of Legislation:

Shining wild animals after 10 p.m. during certain times of the year prohibited.

Amend s. 29.314(5)(a) to read:

29.314(5)(a) Prohibition. No person may use or possess with intent to use a light for shining wild animals between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. from September 1 to ~~December~~ January 31st.

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: shining wild animals during a certain period of each year.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits, with limited exceptions, the shining of wild animals by a person while hunting or while in possession of a firearm, crossbow, or bow and arrow. This prohibition applies 24 hours a day and year round. Current law defines "shining" to be the casting of rays of light for the purpose of illuminating or locating wild animals.

Current law also prohibits, with limited exceptions, the shining of wild animals under any circumstances after 10:00 p.m. and before 7:00 a.m. each day from September 15 to December 31. This bill extends the December 31st date through January 31st.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 29.314 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
