Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) may construct and maintain waysides along, or in close proximity with, state trunk highways. DOT also has the discretion of closing an existing wayside.

This bill requires DOT to hold a public hearing before it decides to close an existing wayside. The public hearing shall be advertised and shall be held in a courthouse or other public place in or near the region that would be affected by the proposed closing.

- 3 presented at the public hearing before determining that it will close a wayside.
