

Whereas, Mrs. Andrae, having a fervent interest in botany and horticulture, took on the enormous task, with the aid of forestry consultants, of reforesting their property; and

Whereas, upon the death of her beloved husband, Frank Theodore Andrae, in 1927, Mrs. Andrae donated her entire lakeshore property to the state of Wisconsin to be used as a state park in December of 1928; and

Whereas, the beautiful forests, beaches, and dunes of Terry Andrae State Park have provided a beautiful and much-cherished recreational area for the families of Sheboygan County and the rest of the state for the past 75 years; now, therefore, be it
