The suspended rule specified that in order for an area to be eligible for aerial treatment with insecticide under a program to suppress the infestation of gypsy moths, the area must be of at least 40 contiguous acres in a compact and regular shape or be of at least 20 acres of publicly owned land surrounded by ineligible land.
