1 AN ACT *to create* 19.36 (13) of the statutes; **relating to:** withholding utility 2 security system plans from public inspection.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	SECTION 1. 19.36 (13) of the statutes is created to read:
4	19.36 (13) UTILITY SECURITY SYSTEM PLANS. (a) In this subsection:
5	1. "Security system plan" means a plan for the physical or electronic security
6	of facilities or information technology systems owned or operated by a utility,
7	including any information, photograph, audio or visual presentation, schematic
8	diagram, survey, recommendation, consultation, or other communication related to
9	such a plan, and including any threat assessment, vulnerability or capability
10	assessment, or threat response plan or any emergency evacuation plan.

2. "Utility" means a cooperative association organized under ch. 185 for the
 purpose of producing or furnishing heat, light, power, or water to its members only
 or a public utility, as defined in s. 196.01 (5).

- (b) An authority may withhold access to any record containing a security
 system plan or a portion of a security system plan if the authority determines that
 a facility or system that is the subject of the plan is so vital to the state that the
 incapacity or destruction of the facility or system would have a debilitating impact
 on the physical or economic security of the state or on public health, safety, or welfare.
