Champagne, Rick Amendments to SB 41

Hi Rick--

More amendments. Please call me if you have any questions or comments.

- 1. The length of any compact may not exceed 30 years.
- 2. All compacts negotiated or to be negotiated within the biennium shall be brought to the legislature at the same time for joint approval (all of them at the same time so different compact parties can't play off of each other).
- 3. Before approval by the Legislature, compacts must pass a state-wide advisory referendum.
- 4. Before approval by the Legislature, compacts must pass a state-wide advisory referendum, and such referendum must be held on the date of general elections in 2004, 2006, etc. (at same time Senators are up for election)
- 5. Prior to approval or disapproval of a compact, each Legislative House must hold at least 2 public hearings regarding the compacts. One hearing in Madison, and One hearing outside of Madison.
- 6. Any loss of revenue caused or occasioned by the compact cannot be made up by any tax increases in income tax, sales tax, property tax, etc.
