## 2003 SENATE BILL 91

April 2, 2003 – Introduced by Senators Reynolds and Stepp, cosponsored by Representatives Gundrum, Grothman, Ladwig and Hines. Referred to Joint Committee on Retirement Systems.

AN ACT *to renumber and amend* 40.02 (24) (a) and 40.02 (24) (b); and *to create*40.02 (24) (a) 2., 40.02 (24) (b) 2. and 40.22 (2) (m) of the statutes; **relating to:**participation in the Wisconsin Retirement System by supreme court justices,
court of appeals judges, circuit judges, and state elected officials.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, supreme court justices, court of appeals judges, circuit judges, and state, county, and municipal officials elected by vote of the people are participants in the Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS). This bill limits the WRS participation of supreme court justices, court of appeals judges, circuit judges, and state elected officials to those individuals whose initial terms of office were before the bill's effective date.

This bill will be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Retirement Systems for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
