Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

There is no data with which to estimate how many WRS participants would qualify for increased military service credit based upon their active service in the U. S. maritime service aboard an oceangoing vessel during the period December 7, 1941 and August 15,1945 and who terminated WRS covered employment after May 31, 1988 but before April 28, 1990.

In 1993, the Department of Employee Trust Funds estimated tht 10 persons would qualify for increased military service credit under a bill identical to Senate Bill 93.

It is assumed that 7 persons would qualify for future increased WRS annuity benefits under this bill, that the average additional military service recognized is 3 yers and that the final average salary of the 7 persons averaged \$30,000. Based on these assumptions, it is estimated that this bill would increase GPR appropriations under s.20.515 (1)(a), stats by \$10,080 annually.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Additional costs under s.20.515 would continue during the life of the affected participants and their beneficiaries.
