Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2003 SB104 would prohibit the use of fireworks at certain indoor venues.

S. 167.10, Stats., indicates statutory requirements for the use of fireworks. The Department administers Comm 14, which indicates fire prevention standards for the use of fireworks. The statutory requirements are for the most part administered by local units of government. Due to the Department's limited involvement in administering the requirements indicated by this bill, there would be no fiscal impact on the Department.

Local units of government issue permits for the use of fireworks and, under this bill, would not issue permits for the use of fireworks at certain indoor venues. Therefore, the bill may result in reduced permitting costs and revenue. The amount is not estimable because data regarding the amount of this type of permitting is not available.
