Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the use of fireworks at certain indoor venues that have a capacity of more than 500 persons. Forfeiture, misdemeanor and felony penalties are created for violations depending upon whether the violation results in bodily harm to or the death of a person.

It is impossible to predict the number of violations that would occur if this bill is enacted but the number is not expected to be significant. It is expected that the resulting workload would be absorbed by existing court staff
