Mary and Robin:

We have another JCRAR rule objection. I was hoping we could avoid this, but when no one from DNR showed up at the hearing, the 10-0 vote was a foregone conclusion. Anyway, a portion of Clearinghouse Rule 02-60 was objected to. I'll send you a copy of the rule through inter-d--the version of the rule on folio is not current; it was modified in negotiations with a standing committee. I've also attached the committee motion, which was adopted on March 6, 2003.

I think the bill draft should be uncomplicated. I'd suggest amending s. 287.235, Stats., so that the agency is prohibited from using the population of an applicant as a criterion in determining whether to award a grant. The next JCRAR meeting probably take place on or around March 27.

1 AN ACT /...; relating to: consideration of population in determining eligibility for  
2 recycling efficiency incentive grants.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Current law requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to make recycling efficiency incentive grants to local units of government that are responsible for operating recycling programs (responsible units).

This bill prohibits DNR from considering the population of a responsible unit in determining eligibility for a recycling efficiency incentive grant.

This bill is introduced as required by s. 227.19 (5) (e), stats., in support of the objection of the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources on February 6, 2003, and the objection of the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules on March 6, 2003, to the issuance of a portion of clearinghouse rule number 02-60 by DNR. The proposed rule provided several ways for a responsible unit to be eligible for a recycling efficiency incentive grant. One of the ways was only available to a responsible unit with a population of at least 50,000.

For further information see the *local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

3 SECTION 1. 287.235 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:



**BILL**

**SECTION 1**

1           287.235 (1) ELIGIBILITY. Beginning in fiscal year 2002-03 the department shall  
2           make a recycling efficiency incentive grant to a responsible unit. The department  
3           may not consider the population of a responsible unit in determining eligibility for  
4           a recycling efficiency incentive grant.
