

2003 SENATE BILL 125

April 29, 2003 – Introduced by Senators DECKER, WIRCH and HANSEN, cosponsored by Representatives M. WILLIAMS, MILLER, HAHN, TURNER, WASSERMAN, TOWNSEND, SERATTI, WEBER, PLOUFF, BIES, LASSA and VAN ROY. Referred to Committee on Transportation and Information Infrastructure.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 84.1041 of the statutes; **relating to:** designating and marking
2 the bridge on STH 13 across the south fork of the Flambeau River in the town
3 of Fifield in Price County as Freedoms Bridge.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to designate and mark the bridge on STH 13 across the south fork of the Flambeau River in the town of Fifield in Price County as “Freedoms Bridge” in honor and recognition of all veterans who fought to preserve freedoms in the Korean War.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 84.1041 of the statutes is created to read:
5 **84.1041 Freedoms Bridge.** The department shall designate and mark the
6 bridge on STH 13 across the south fork of the Flambeau River in the town of Fifield
7 in Price County that, as of the effective date of this section [revisor inserts date],
