	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 43.30 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	43.30 (1) Records of any library which is in whole or in part supported by public
5	funds, including the records of a public library system, indicating the identity of any
6	individual who borrows or uses the library's documents or other materials, resources,
7	or services may not be disclosed except by court order or to persons acting within the
8	scope of their duties in the administration of the library or library system, to persons
9	authorized by the individual to inspect such records <u>, to parents or guardians of</u>
10	children under the age of 14 as required under sub. (4), or to libraries as authorized
11	under subs. (2) and (3).
12	SECTION 2. 43.30 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

43.30 (4) Upon the request of a parent or guardian of a child who is under the
age of 14, a library supported in whole or part by public funds shall disclose to the
parent or guardian all library records relating to library documents or other
materials used by that child that are overdue or lost.
