

2003 SENATE BILL 179

May 23, 2003 – Introduced by Senators CHVALA and CARPENTER, cosponsored by Representatives TURNER and MUSSEY, by request of Harry McCarthy. Referred to Committee on Labor, Small Business Development and Consumer Affairs.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 100.53 of the statutes; **relating to:** magazine subscription
2 refunds and requiring the exercise of rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a magazine owner or publisher from entering into a contract or agreement to sell issues of a magazine by subscription to a person unless the contract or agreement entitles the subscriber to cancel the subscription and receive a prorated refund of the subscription price.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 100.53 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **100.53 Magazine subscription refunds. (1)** No magazine owner or
5 publisher or agent of a magazine owner or publisher may enter into a contract or
6 agreement to sell issues of a magazine by subscription to a person in this state unless
7 the contract or agreement entitles the subscriber to cancel the subscription before

1 the expiration of the subscription period and to receive a prorated refund of the full
2 amount of the subscription price.

3 (2) The department shall, by rule, define “magazine” for purposes of this
4 section.

5 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

6 (1) This act first applies to contracts or agreements to sell issues of a magazine
7 that are entered into on the effective date of this subsection.

8 **SECTION 3. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,
9 except as follows:

10 (1) The treatment of section 100.53 (1) of the statutes and SECTION 2 (1) of this
11 act take effect on the first day of the 2nd month beginning after publication.
