Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department to write administrative rules to define the word "magazine." The process of rule writing takes a minimum of 12 months, starting with filing a scope statement, creating a hearing draft, Board of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer approval for public hearings, creation and Board approval of the final draft, and legislative referral and review.

These activities, while significant, can be absorbed by existing resources.
