Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may operate a motor vehicle that is required to be equipped with safety belts unless the operator is wearing a safety belt and the operator ensures that each passenger between four and fifteen years of age is wearing a safety belt or is otherwise properly restrained. A person who fails to comply with these requirements may be required to forfeit \$10. Further, each passenger who is four years of age or older is required to wear a safety belt or be otherwise properly restrained. A passenger who fails to comply with this requirement and is at least 16 years of age when the violation occurs may be required to forfeit \$10.

This bill increases the forfeiture for each violation from \$10 to \$50.
