1 AN ACT to create 16.502, 25.17 (1) (ty) and 25.38 of the statutes; relating to:  
2 creating a fund to reduce state revenue shortfalls.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill creates a separate nonlapsible trust fund to which any taxpayer may contribute any amount of money. The fund is called the tax-me-more fund, and amounts contributed to the fund may be used only to reduce the state's revenue shortfalls.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 16.502 of the statutes is created to read:

4 16.502 Transfers to the general fund from the tax-me-more fund. If the  
5 secretary determines under s. 16.50 (7) (a) that previously authorized expenditures  
6 will exceed revenues in the current or forthcoming fiscal year by more than 0.5% of  
7 the estimated general purpose revenue appropriations for that fiscal year, the  
8 secretary shall transfer all moneys in the tax-me-more fund to the general fund.

25.17 (1) (ty) Tax-me-more fund (s. 25.38);

SECTION 3. 25.38 <sup>✓</sup> of the statutes is created to read:

**25.38 Tax-me-more fund.** There is established a separate nonlapsible trust fund designated as the tax-me-more fund, to consist of all moneys contributed by taxpayers <sup>, and which shall be sent to the department of revenue,</sup> for the purpose of reducing the state's revenue shortfalls. Moneys in the fund may be used only to make the transfer under s. 16.502.
