Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a separate nonlapsible trust fund, called the tax-me-more fund, to which any taxpayer may contribute any amount of money. The amounts contributed to the fund, which shall be sent to the department of revenue, will be used only to reduce the state's revenue shortfalls.

It is assumed that few will contribute to the tax-me-more fund, so there will be no need to change current tax forms or to develop a special program to capture and record the contributions made by taxpayers. DOR will deposit and record properly any contributions that were made using its current accounting system
