Becky,

Based on testimony we received during the hearing on LRB 2667/2 AN ACT *to create* 295.16 (4) (k) of the statutes; **relating to:** an exemption from requirements for nonmetallic mining reclamation.

We would like to request an amendment which would be offered in committee.

The amendment would require that;

The individual intending to construct a pond/wetland under the provisions of 295.16 (4) (k) notify the county land conservation office in the county of construction of their intent to begin construction under this exemption.

The pond/wetland constructed under this provision be completed in no more than 18 months.

Specify that any materials removed from the site may be initially stockpiled on the site for no more than 12 months and if the individual constructing the pond/wetland wishes for an extension of time on the stockpiling of materials, that they make a request for an extension of up to 24 months which must be granted county land conservation office.

The land conservation office could under this extension provisions require that the stockpile be appropriately sloped and seeded to mitigate any possible runoff into local waterbodies.
