Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill permits the Department of Administration to enter into a contract with the Historical Society to conduct a survey of the condition of the facilities and the infrastructure of historic sites owned by the society to prepare a needs assessment and master plan. It is indeterminate at this time how many sites might be selected and the scope of such contracts. A program statement detailing the study would be developed.

The contracts would be let under the authority of the Building Commission from advance planning funds for possible projects to be included in the Building Program.
