AN ACT to amend 77.54 (46) of the statutes; relating to: a sales tax and use tax

exemption for military services flags, POW/MIA flags, and flag kits.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, sales of the U.S. flag and the state flag are exempt from the sales tax and the use tax. Under this bill, sales of the U.S. flag, the state flag, the Prisoner of War/Missing in Action flag, a military services flag, and accessories that are packaged with such flags, are exempt from the sales tax and the use tax.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

For further information see the state and local fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 77.54 (46) of the statutes at the hope 2001 Wissonsh Not amended to read:

77.54 (46) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use, or other consumption of the U.S. flag or, the state flag, the "POW/MIA" flag, or a military

Technical Memorandum on SB 208 regarding Exempting Sales of POW/MIA and

Military Service Flags from Sales Tax

We have the following technical concerns with the bill:

- The phrase "military services flag" may be too general in that the exemption appears to include all military services flags (for example, flags of the armed forces of other countries, Confederate battle flags and Nazi military flags, Korean War veterans flags, Vietnam insignia flags).
- 2. It is not clear whether the exemption would include "Service" flags (formerly known as "Sons in Service" flags) which are hung by families in a front window to indicate that a family member is serving in the US Armed Forces. Since the design and manufacture of these flags is approved by the US Secretary of Defense under Title 36, United States Code, Section 901, limiting the exemption to such flags would target and clarify the exemption.
- 3. The phrase "and before a sale to the final consumer" might be read as a separate exemption for accessories that are not required to be packaged with a flag. For example, flag hardware and a pole may be packaged together without a flag. The bill may be read to exempt the hardware and pole because these accessories are packaged before a sale to the final consumer.

Deleting the word "and" from line 2 of page 2 would clarify that the phrase "before a sale to the final consumer" refers to the packaging of the accessories with the flags.
