Waiting Period for License Issuance

Motion:

Move to provide that the requirement that sheriffs generally wait seven days before issuing licenses would not apply to applicants for which a background search is not required.

---

Note:

Under the substitute amendment, a sheriff would be required to issue a concealed weapons license without requesting a background check if the applicant was: (1) a law enforcement officer; (2) a correctional officer; (3) a probation, parole, and extended supervision agent; or (4) a person with a current certification from the Law Enforcement Standards Board under s. 165.85(3)(c) [law enforcement, tribal law enforcement, jail or secured detention officers]. The substitute amendment generally requires sheriffs to wait seven days before issuing concealed weapons licenses to permit Justice to conduct required background checks. This motion would clarify that this waiting period would not apply to applicants for which a background check is not required.
