- **7.** Page 50, line 10: delete "2." and substitute "943.13 (1m) (c)".
- **8.** Page 50, line 15: delete "subdivision" and substitute "paragraph".
- **9.** Page 51, line 10: delete "(c) 2." and substitute "(c)".
- 5 **10.** Page 51, line 22: after that line insert:
- **SECTION 53g.** 943.14 of the statutes is renumbered 943.14 (1).
- **SECTION 53k.** 943.14 (2) of the statutes is created to read:
 - 943.14 **(2)** No individual may intentionally enter or remain in the dwelling of another without the consent of some person lawfully upon the premises after having told the person that he or she is going armed with a concealed and dangerous weapon.
- 11 A person who violates this prohibition is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.".
