

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 70,
TO 2003 SENATE BILL 214**

November 5, 2003 – Offered by Representatives GUNDERSON, W. WOOD and
UNDERHEIM.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 10, line 22: delete lines 22 to 25 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 11m.** 59.25 (3) (u) of the statutes is created to read:

4 59.25 (3) (u) 1. In this paragraph, “allocated license fees” means all money
5 received by the sheriff under s. 175.50 (7) (bd) or (15) (b) 4. a. or, if the sheriff is a party
6 to an agreement under s. 175.50 (2) (c), all money allocated to the sheriff under the
7 agreement from money received under s. 175.50 (7) (bd) or (15) (b) 4. a.

8 2. Deposit all of the following in the general fund of the county:

9 a. All allocated license fees, other than money derived from allocated license
10 fees that is deposited under subd. 5. b. in the segregated fund created under subd.

11 5. a.

12 b. All money received by the sheriff under s. 175.50 (7) (bp), (13), and (15) (b)
13 4. c., or, if the sheriff is a party to an agreement under s. 175.50 (2) (c), all money

1 allocated to the sheriff under the agreement from money received under s. 175.50 (7)
2 (bp), (13), and (15) (b) 4. c.

3 3. Forward all money received under s. 175.50 (7) (bh) and (15) (b) 4. b. to the
4 state treasurer for deposit in the general fund.

5 4. Deposit in the law enforcement excellence fund established under s. 175.50
6 (20) all money received by the sheriff under s. 175.50 (7) (bt) and (15) (b) 4. d., or, if
7 the sheriff is a party to an agreement under s. 175.50 (2) (c), all money allocated to
8 the sheriff under the agreement from money received under s. 175.50 (7) (bt) and (15)
9 (b) 4. d., and make payments from the fund for the purposes of s. 175.50 (20) (b).

10 5. a. Establish a segregated fund, payments from which may be used by the
11 sheriff for law enforcement purposes but which may not be used to supplant or
12 replace other funds otherwise available to the sheriff.

13 b. Deposit the amount of money, as determined by the treasurer, by which the
14 allocated license fees exceed the county's costs in issuing licenses to carry a concealed
15 weapon under s. 175.50, including any such costs incurred under an agreement
16 under s. 175.50 (2) (c).

17 c. Make payments from the fund as directed by the sheriff.”.

18 **2.** Page 11, line 1: delete lines 1 to 6.

19 **3.** Page 11, line 17: delete “training requirements” and substitute “firearms
20 training requirements similar to those in s. 175.50 (4m) (a) to (g)”.

21 **4.** Page 29, line 5: after “shall” insert “provide the person taking the course or
22 class with information regarding electric weapons, as defined in s. 941.295 (4), and
23 shall”.

24 **5.** Page 44, line 19: after that line insert:

1 “5m. A place at which an organized youth sporting event is taking place.”

2 **6.** Page 45, line 3: delete lines 3 to 5.

3 **7.** Page 45, line 15: delete that line and substitute:

4 “13. A building or part of a building used by a health care facility, as defined
5 in s. 150.84 (2), or by a clinic or office that is used by a physician licensed under ch.
6 448.”.

7 **8.** Page 61, line 10: delete “statutes takes” and substitute “statutes and
8 SECTION 57 (1) of this act take”.
