Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The Department is unable to project the number of offenders who will be convicted under the penalty provisions of this bill or what precise penalties would be assessed. There will be a state fiscal impact if additional offenders are sentenced to prison or placed on probation. Local costs will increase if offenders are sent to jail as a condition of probation. The FY 02 annual cost to place an inmate in a DOC institution is approximately \$26,000 and \$1900 for community supervision.
