## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates new crimes related to use of controlled substances. Because this bill creates new crimes, it's likely that the State Public Defender's Office will handle additional cases, thus increasing the agency's costs. Because it is presently unknown how many people would be charged with these new crimes, and of those charged, how many would qualify for SPD representation, the agency cannot estimate the costs at this time.
