NOTICE TO HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS< COMPLAINANTS< PATIENTS AND CLIENTS CONCERNING DISCIPLINARY CASE. (a) in this subsection, "complainant" means a person who has requested the department or a health care credentialing authority to investigate a health care professional for possible unprofessional conduct.

(b) The department shall notify a health care professional in writing within 30 days after any of the following, unless the department determines that notification would impede the ability of the department or of a law enforcement agency to effectively investigate or otherwise proceed against the health care professional.
