Hi Mark. I wonder if you would draft an amendment for Rep. Gielow for tomorrow's meeting of the Assembly Health Committee, if that's still possible?

The State Medical Society has a concern that AA1 applies to situations where cases are closed. They believe that notification to a physician SHOULD occur in those case-closed situations, because:


- 1) it would help the physician know if there's an area of his/her practice where improvement could be made. The state withholding information on a closed case is odd: does the state wish the physician to screw up again, but worse the next time so a better case can be made? That doesn't sound like the best interests for the public . . .
- 2) when a professional is investigated by the state, doesn't that professional have the right to know that an investigation happened and was closed?

Our request (and the Medical Society's suggestion): have AA1 apply only to 440.037 (4)(b)(2), but not (4)(b)(1) or (4)(b)(3).

As a reminder, SB 227 is set for an exec tomorrow in Assembly Health at 9:30 AM.
