Peter,

On behalf of Senator Darling, I would like to place a request for a bill to be drafted that would expand the authorization process for UW-System schools (both 2-year and 4-year) to sponsor charter schools. I know there is language currently in place that encompasses UW-Milwaukee and UW-Parkside. I would like to leave the current law affecting those two institutions alone, as there was language included dealing with those two colleges that I don't want to carry forward.

Initially, I would like the bill to give broad authorization for these UW-System schools to charter their own schools. During the hearing process, the legislation will undoubtedly be tightened, as interested parties work on a compromise.

I would like to make sure the bill allows the UW institutions to sponsor a school over coming years, but the charter schools could only start up after July 1, 2005.

If possible, I would like to have a draft ready by the end of next week to show the Senator. Thank you and please call if you have questions. Have a great weekend!

Only pupils who reside in the school district in which an independent charter school is located may attend the charter school.

This bill allows a pupil who resides outside the Milwaukee school district to attend an independent charter school located in the Milwaukee school district. The bill also explicitly authorizes a school board to transport pupils to and from a charter school. If a school board elects to do so, it receives state transportation aid.
