11	subsection, in March the department shall pay to the unified school district in which
12	the charter school is located, from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (fm), an

amount equal to the amount of school aid per pupil to which the unified school district
is eligible in the current school year multiplied by the number of pupils attending the
charter school who were previously enrolled in the unified school district. <u>No</u>
payment may be made under this subdivision after June 30, 2004.
SECTION 5h. 121.08 (4) (a) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin
Act 33, is renumbered 121.08 (4) (a) and amended to read:
121.08 (4) (a) The amount of state aid that a school district is eligible to be paid
from the appropriations under s. 20.255 (2) (ac) and (r) shall be reduced by the \underline{an}
amount determined as follows: <u>equal to the sum of the amounts paid under s. 118.40</u>
(2r) (e) in the current school year to charter schools located in the school district.
SECTION 5p. 121.08 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is repealed.
SECTION 5t. 121.08 (4) (a) 2. and 3. of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin
Act 33, are repealed.".
4. Page 3, line 11: after that line insert:
"SECTION 6m. Initial applicability.
(1) This act first applies to the distribution of school aid in the 2004–05 school
year.".
