Yes, in fact I am working on it right now. Since you asked, I'm kind of hung up on "curricular oriented class." Would it be better to require that the pupil earn an equivalent number of credits in an academic subject? In other words, current law now requires 1.5 credits in PE. If those credits are satisfied by participating in a sport, the pupil would have to earn an additional 1.5 credits in the subjects listed in s. 118.33 (1) (a) 1. or 2. of the statutes.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires a high school pupil to earn 1.5 credits in physical education in order to be eligible for a high school diploma. This bill authorizes a school board to grant a pupil credit in physical education for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is watched by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 118.33 (1) (e) A school board may grant a pupil credit in physical education
- 5 under par. (a) 1. for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is watered
- 6 by a person who is licensed to teach physical education (INS. 1-6)
 - Section 2. Initial applicability.
