118.33 (1)(e) A school board may exempt a pupil from the physical education requirement under para (a) 1. for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is sanctioned by the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association. Further, require that a student who opts out of the physical education requirement must therefore partake in a curriculum orientated class in that credit hour.

Yes, in fact I am working on it right now. Since you asked, I'm kind of hung up on "curricular oriented class." Would it be better to require that the pupil earn an equivalent number of credits in an academic subject? In other words, current law now requires 1.5 credits in PE. If those credits are satisfied by participating in a sport, the pupil would have to earn an additional 1.5 credits in the subjects listed in s. 118.33 (1) (a) 1. or 2. of the statutes.

1 **AN ACT to create** 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes; **relating to:** granting high school

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires a high school pupil to earn 1.5 credits in physical education in order to be eligible for a high school diploma. This bill authorizes a school board to grant a pupil credit in physical education for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is ~~watched by a person who is licensed to teach physical education~~ *INS. A*
