Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill changes the mediation/arbitration provisions of the municipal employment relations act. Among other changes, the bill would require an arbitrator to give greater weight to the financial ability of the municipal employer to meet the costs required under a labor contract settlement. However, the Office of State Employment Relations does not have information available to estimate the impact of the bill on labor relations costs, wage rates, or other employment-related costs.
