Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

With certain exceptions, this bill generally prohibits a financial institution from disclosing personal, financial information about a customer unless the customer "opts in" or consents to the disclosure. The department has rule-making and enforcement responsibilities associated with disclosure of financial records by financial institutions.

Procedures to verify that financial institutions have adopted reasonable procedures to assure compliance will need to be added to certain examinations. These examination steps will add approximately 525 hours (.25 FTE) each year to examination time.
