## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits certain threats to cause bodily harm to the person or family member of a social service worker employed by or working under contract with a government agency, a juvenile intake worker, or a school employee. A threat is covered by this prohibition if: 1) the person making the threat knows or should have known that the victim is, or is a family member of, a social service worker, juvenile intake worker, or a school employee; 2) at the time of the threat, the victim is acting in his or her official capacity or the threat is made in response to any action taken in an official capacity; 3) the victim did not consent to the threat.

This bill has no fiscal effect on the Department of Public Instruction.

This bill has no fiscal effect on local school districts.
