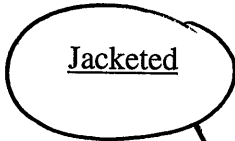

1 AN ACT relating to: ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state
 2 of Wisconsin and the District 1199W/United Professionals for Quality Health
 3 Care, SEIU, AFL-CIO, for the ~~2001-03~~ biennium, covering employees in the
 4 professional patient care collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an
 5 expenditure of funds.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employees in the professional patient care collective bargaining unit negotiated for the ~~2001-03~~ biennium under the State Employment Labor Relations Act. Currently, statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SENATE BILL 149

1 **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative
 2 agreement negotiated for the ~~2001-03~~ ²⁰⁰³⁻⁰⁵ biennium between the state of Wisconsin,
 3 ~~department~~ ^{the office of state} of employment relations, and the District 1199W/United Professionals
 4 for Quality Health Care, SEIU, AFL-CIO, covering employees in the professional
 5 patient care collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111 of the
 6 statutes, as approved by the employees of the professional patient care collective
 7 bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the joint committee on
 8 employment relations, and authorizes the necessary expenditure of moneys for
 9 implementation from the appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes,
 10 subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The ~~secretary~~ ^{director} of ~~employment~~ ^{the office of state}
 11 relations shall file an official copy of the agreement, certified by the cochairpersons
 12 of the joint committee on employment relations, with the secretary of state. No
 13 formal or informal agreement between the parties that is not a part of the official
 14 copy is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

16 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those
 17 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
 18 covering employees in the professional patient care collective bargaining unit are
 19 effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
