Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill will allow for white tail deer farms that were licensed by the DNR in 2002, prior to the effective date of 2001 Wisconsin Act 56 which requires hunting preserves to have 80 acres or more contiguous acres, to be grandfathered in and allowed to hold hunts as long as they were qualified to hold hunts previously.

This bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department.
