2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 329

1 AN ACT relating to: expenditure of \$56,300 from moneys appropriated to the
2 department of transportation in payment of a claim against the state made by
3 the city of West Allis.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

* This bill directs expenditure of \$56,300 from moneys appropriated to the department of transportation (DOT) for the current fiscal biennium for improvement of existing state trunk highways and connecting highways and bridges, for construction and rehabilitation of interstate highways, and for certain related programs in payment of a claim against DOT by the city of West Allis. In 1994-95, the city incurred real estate acquisition costs in connection with an improvement project for South 84th Street, 80% of which would have been eligible for federal and state financial participation if an application for approval of federal financial participation had been timely filed. The city relied upon DOT to file the application, but due to an oversight by a DOT employee the application was not filed in a timely manner. On October 19, 1999, the claims board recommended payment of this claim (see 1999 Senate Journal, p. 308). percent

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

ASSEMBLY BILL 329

SECTION 1

1 **SECTION 1. Claim against the state.** There is directed to be expended from the
2 appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (cq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of
3 ~~1999 and 2001~~, ^{2001 and 2003} \$56,300 in payment of a claim against the city of
4 West Allis as reimbursement for 80% of the real estate acquisition costs incurred by
5 the city in the improvement of South 84th Street in 1994-95, which would have been percent
6 paid with federal and state aid but for the failure of an employee of the department
7 of transportation to obtain prior approval for federal financial participation in the
8 improvement project. Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers,
9 employees, and agents from any further liability resulting from expenses incurred
10 by the city in constructing this improvement project.
