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

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

Re: Amendment to Senate Bill 336 (LRB 3376/1)

Senator Roessler would like an amendment drafted to Senate Bill 336, relating to creating the option to make an anatomical gift as part of a living will.

The following changes should be included in the amendment:

- Page 5 line 10: Delete "organs" and replace with, "organs, tissues and eyes."
- Page 5 line 11: Delete "my body" and replace with "organs, tissues and eyes."
- Page 5, line 13: Delete "parts or organs" and replace with "organs, tissues and eyes."
- Page 5 line 13: Add the word "only" between the words "donate and the."
- Page 5 line 14: After the word gift, list several body parts for a person to choose from. A list of the organs and tissues is attached.
- Page 5 line 17: Rather than stating, "I want to donate all or part of my body to..." Senator Roessler would like to change 157.06 (6) (b) of the statutes to indicate that a person can designate a specific donee, but if transplantation cannot occur, anyone in need would be eligible to receive the donated organs, tissues or eyes.
- Page 5 line 18: Delete "I want to donate all or part of my body for this purpose..." Replace with language that would indicate that if transplantation is not able to occur (or organs are unsuitable for transplant), the person can indicate a desire for his or her organs, tissues and eyes to be donated for research and/or education (possibly a check off box).
- Page 5 line 19: Delete "I want Dr. ...(name of physician) to carry out the appropriate procedures." Also delete 157.06 (2) (d) of the statutes.
- Page 5 line 21: Delete "all or any part of my body" and replace with, "any organs, tissues or eyes."

Senator Roessler would also like to know if we could include information on the form about where a person could obtain more information about organ, tissue and eye donation. For example, information relating to organ procurement organizations, tissue banks, and eye banks.

Hi Jennifer,

The only question that I have about these comments is that there are situations, I think, in which a person might wish to donate their entire body for medical study rather than just organs, tissues or eyes. I know that medical students and others are in need of cadavers which are used to learn about the structure of the human body. The second and last bullet in this memo seem to remove the option of donating one's entire body, rather than certain organs, tissues and eyes. I would add another bullet to add the following option after line 11 on page 5: "YES, I want to donate all of my organs, tissues and eyes as an anatomical gift."

On page 5, line 21, I would delete the last bullet and insert the following instead: "after 'body' insert 'or any organs, tissues or eyes'."

If you want I can call the UW people to make sure I am not off-base.

I looked at the uniform anatomical gift act and the comments don't indicate why a person is given the ability to choose the physician who will do the procedure. I'll check a little further and let you know if I find anything.

Hi,

Carol had a meeting with a transplant surgeon from UW Hospital regarding SB 336 (organ donation and living will). He had some suggestions for an amendment that Carol is planning to pursue.

Below is the memo I sent to Debora Kennedy regarding the changes Carol would like included in the amendment. Debora and I are going to talk next week about the memo to make sure we are on the same page. If you have suggestions about any of the changes, please share them with us. As part of the amendment, Carol would like to repeal current law which allows a donor to choose the physician that will carry out the procedure. Do you know anything about why this is in the statutes to begin with? The language I am talking about can be found in 157.06 (2) (d) of the statutes. Lisa Maroney, the Assistant Director for State Relations for UW, talked to someone at the Medical College of WI. who thought that the current language may have been adopted before organ procurement organizations were around. Debora Kennedy did not remember any history behind allowing the person to choose the physician either.

We will not be execing on SB 336 Tuesday because we still need the fiscal note and likely won't have the amendment ready.

Just one more quick thing, the attached memo indicates that I have included a list of organs and tissues that can be donated. I don't have an electronic copy but can send a hard copy to you if you want it.

In comparing the living will form in ch. 154 and the power of attorney for health care form in ch. 155, I notice that there is a statement in ch. 155 that says "In addition, I may, by this document, specify my wishes with respect to making an anatomical gift upon my death."

It might be advisable to add a similar provision in the ch. 154 living will form. Perhaps it could be added at the end of the first paragraph of the form in s. 154.03(2). I think the anatomical gift provisions in SB 336 would fit better if this language was added to the form.

1. Page 2 of Senate Amendment:

Page 5, line 17: delete that line and substitute:

"a. I want to donate my: ... (list the organs or tissues) to: ... (name of the donee), but if that person is not able to be a transplant recipient, then I donate to anyone for whom the anatomical gift is suitable."

2. Page 5, line 22 of SB 336

Delete "(If this revokes a prior committment that I have made to make an anatomical gift to a designated donee, I will attempt to notify the donee to which or to whom I agreed to donate.)"
