## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill would create an elected metropolitian sewerage commission from eleven equal districts in place of an appointed commission for the Milwaukee area. There would be one time costs to establish districts. Recent redistricting in Milwaukee County are estimated to have had costs approximating \$50,000 to \$100,000, with the benefit on onging IT support and experienced in-house staff. As other counites would be involved as a result of this bill and because a new process is proposed costs might be expected to exceed this figure. After each decennial census these costs would recur.

The election of commissioners would be added to the Spring elections in Wisconsin. This bill would likely increase the cost in the Spring elections of local clerks in commission jurdisdictions to print ballots with the correct combinations of added office holders and added costs to manage correct maps and lists for the new sewerage commissioner districts in addition to the other election districts. The addition of office holders and the right of recall raises the possibilities of special elections for recall, however, these costs cannot be determined ahead of time.
